**REGISTRATION**

Registration for students in grades Pre-Kindergarten – 12 of Deer Creek-Mackinaw Community Unit School District No. 701 is online through the Parent Portal for families enrolled in the district at the end of the previous school year. Please watch for an email from the Technology Department when the portal for registration and payments for fees opens. For families new to the district, or those that do not have access to the internet, please contact the appropriate school office immediately after August 1<sup>st</sup> to register.

Fees are to be paid after submission of online forms, whether sending a check by via mail or on site. Lunch fees may be paid with registration payment or can be paid online through the district’s website [www.deemack.org](http://www.deemack.org) through the parent portal. Any family that is “Direct Certified” through the State of Illinois will receive a letter from the district listing all students living in your household who will receive free lunches. If you receive one of these letters, you do NOT have to fill out an application. Those of you that received free or reduced meals last year and were determined by income, you will be mailed an application to fill out and return to your building principal.

**KINDERGARTEN**

Children must be five years of age on or before September 1, 2018 to enroll in kindergarten. **Certified birth certificates** must be presented to the principal’s office on or before the first day of school.

**PHYSICAL EXAMS**

Complete physicals are required on or before the start of school for students entering kindergarten, sixth grade, and ninth grades. If students do not have a physical, they must have an appointment card from a doctor or dentist. A written note from the parent is not acceptable. Exams must be dated within one

calendar year of entrance to school. Athletic physicals do not satisfy the physical examination requirement but the physical examination will meet the athletic physical requirement. All out-of-state transfer students are required to have physical exams.

### **DENTAL EXAMS**

Complete dental examinations are required on or before the start of school for students entering kindergarten, second, and sixth grades. Examinations must be performed by a licensed dentist, and they must sign the proof of school dental examination form (available in the school office).

### **VISION EXAMS**

The law required comprehensive eye exams for children entering kindergarten, second grade, or enrolling for the first time in public, private, or parochial elementary school in Illinois. The exam must be completed by a qualified eye doctor no later than the first day of school.

### **ATHLETICS PHYSICAL EXAMS/BIRTH CERTIFICATE/INSURANCE**

All student athletes, including cheerleaders and pom poms, must have a completed physical exam and birth certificate on file in the principal's office before participation is allowed.

### **IMMUNIZATIONS**

If your child is not in compliance with the immunization requirements established by the Illinois Department of Health, he/she will not be allowed to attend classes on the first day of school, Wednesday, August 15, 2018.

### **FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL**

The first day of attendance for students in Deer Creek-Mackinaw Unit School District #701 will be **Wednesday, August 15, 2018 with an early dismissal at 1:30 p.m.** Any student living more than 1.5 miles from school will be provided bus transportation.
